Derbyshire Amenities

- **Gardens:**
 - Visitors travel from far and wide to admire the gardens of England, famous for their astounding beauty and breadth. Now, these English gardens, designed and tended to by horticulture experts, are the backdrop of the Derbyshire living experience. Growing over and around bridges, roundabouts, gates and walls, the gardens are truly awe-inspiring, spawning wildflowers and ivy in one lush expression of authentic natural beauty.
- **Equestrian Facility**
 - Derbyshire will feature a superior equestrian facility and a dressage ring, which will include a 12-stall master class riding stable, matted box stalls, heat lamps over hot/cold wash bays, an automatic water system, grooming racks and a fire/security system. The center will also feature a separate lounge for riders and an outdoor fire pit for gatherings.
- **Community Center**
 - Like the rest of Derbyshire, the Community Center is a step back in time to another era. Destined to be the gathering place for social events and community functions, it's designed to be reminiscent of an Old English pub, complete with a stately bar, billiard tables and darts. For tea time or a game of bridge, enjoy the garden conservatory, with beautiful views of the still-water lake.
- **Horse Trails**
 - This area of the Carolinas has a rich history of the equestrian lifestyle and is adjacent to the legendary Tryon Hounds hunt country of Polk County. Derbyshire's own equestrian trail system connects to more than 160 miles of horse trails. Many of the trails date back to the 1920's when people came to this area from across the country to fox hunt and enjoy the extraordinary landscape.
- **Exercise Facility**
 - In our state-of-the-art exercise facility, Derbyshire's breath-taking lake is visible and inspiring. Whether working out on the treadmills, free weights, elliptical machines or stationary bikes, the spectacular views and attention to detail are what make this exercise facility more than a gym. On-staff trainers will be available for private sessions. And a massage room is yours for the relaxing. Here, you'll enjoy it all – mind, body and soul.
- **Walking Trails**
 - For early-risers, the perfect way to start the day is with an adventure on walking and biking trails, which lead you through the woods along trickling streams, flowering gardens and calming lake waters. Along the path, you may see a red fox, graceful deer or wild turkey that are drawn to this peaceful place. And it's simply magical to watch the early morning mist rise from the meadows and over the lake.

- **Lake Activities**
 - The spiritual center of Derbyshire. Thirty-three acres and fully stocked, the lake beckons for a fishing expedition at daybreak with the grandkids, a mid-day picnic or a quiet after-dinner walk. The lakeside gazebo will be your perfect spot to rest and slip into a great book. Artfully designed docks will be located at three different points around the lake for residents' convenient access, which will feature individual slips for canoes and kayaks.
- **Lawn Sports**
 - In keeping with English tradition, a lawn court for games such as bowls, or bocce and croquet, will be located on the club's terraces to take advantage of the spectacular lake views.
- **Greenhouse**
 - Situated in the community's cottage area, the Community Greenhouse will provide residents an opportunity to cultivate their own plants and flowers or to spend a lazy afternoon admiring the beauty of their neighbor's botanical pursuits.

- **Pearson's Falls**
 - The Tryon Garden Club provides this site with easy, well-maintained hiking trails, picnic areas, wildflowers, birds, rushing river, and 90-foot waterfall. Open Tuesday-Sunday from Mar. 1 - Oct. 31. Winter Hours: open Wednesday - Sunday (Nov 1 - Mar 1). Nominal admission fee.

- **Bradley Falls**
 - The trail to Big Bradley Falls is part of an unmarked, untended section of the Green River Game Lands - a rugged tract of land owned by the state for hunting and fishing. Hike at your own risk - the trail is primitive and requires crossing the stream. Proper hiking shoes required. The trail is especially dangerous at the top of the falls. Do not attempt to hike to the bottom. Exit 59 off I-26 on Holbert's Cove Road (away from downtown Saluda). Go 3.4 miles to bottom of gorge. Watch for unpaved parking area on left, just before you cross the stream. The unmarked trail starts at the orange gate.

- **North Carolina Arboretum**
 - The 426-acre site is nestled in one of the most beautiful natural settings in the United States next to the Blue Ridge Parkway. Mountain peaks bound the property's visual perimeters and 1.8 miles of the Bent Creek stream run through the center of the Arboretum. 35-minute drive.

- **Blue Ridge Parkway**
 - One of the nation's most beautiful drives is only a few minutes away. Head north on the Parkway to visit the Folk Art Center, Craggy Gardens, and Mount Mitchell. Head south to Mount Pisgah, Looking Glass Rock, and Shining Rock Wilderness. 35-minute drive to access.

- **Lake Lure/Chimney Rock**
 - Chimney Rock Park includes a 404-foot waterfall, hiking trails, a nursery, and spectacular views. It lies in Hickory Nut Gorge (soon to become a state park) and overlooks picturesque Lake Lure. 25-minute drive.

- **Hatcher Garden and Woodland Preserve**
 - Outside of Spartanburg, SC, discover what a retired couple with little money but an incredible dream can accomplish. From red clay land robbed of its fertility by cotton and eroded into deep gullies for lack of topsoil, they created a community green space by amending soil, building paths and ponds, and planting over 10,000 trees, shrubs, and flowers. Visitors now wander the free 10-acre public garden with perennial and annual flower displays, natural areas and woodland gardens, native plants, ponds and lots of wildlife. - **Green River Plantation**
 - Listed on the National Register of Historic Places. This stately home was built in 1804 and has been lovingly restored to its original grandeur. A magnificent, nineteenth-century, forty-two-room mansion resting on 366 acres of land the plantation reflects the gentility and refinement of the pre-Civil War South.
